## SAPC e-Note: Final reminder to comply with 2024 CPD requirements on or before 28 February 2025

According to our records, you have not yet complied with the 2024 CPD requirements by submitting at least six (6) CPD entries for the year 2024. Please find the attached letter concerning your non-compliance with Continuing Professional Development (CPD) requirements and the implications thereof. The South African Pharmacy Council (SAPC) reminds you that the grace period granted to you to comply with the 2024 CPD requirements ends on **Friday, 28 February 2025** in accordance with the amended Section 9(g) of the CPD guidance document (i.e. Board Notice 706 of 2024).

There will be no extension to the grace period; should you not be compliant with the 2024 CPD requirements by the end of the grace period, you will be designated as a non-practising pharmacist or disciplinary action will be instituted against you. A non-practising designation will mean that you will no longer be entitled to practise any or all the prescribed scope of practice of a pharmacist or to perform any act which you, in your capacity as a registered person, are entitled to perform.

You are encouraged to submit your CPD entries early to avoid system-related challenges and errors associated with the last-minute CPD submission rush due to a substantial increase in the number of pharmacists submitting CPD entries on the last day of the grace period.
